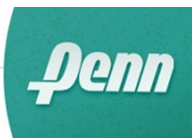

Rules and Eyewear

USA Racquetball [Official Rules](#) will govern competition, including the mandatory use of protective eyewear tested to impact standards. It is the player's responsibility to ensure that their eyewear conforms with the standard in Rule 2.5 (a).

Eligibility

Only U.S. Citizens or individuals who have an active application for Citizenship may compete in the U.S. Team Qualifying divisions; all other age & skill divisions are open to U.S. Citizens and residents. For age division competition, players must meet the age requirement as of the first day of competition.

Deadlines, Refunds and Fees

Players who enter by the Early Bird deadline will receive a can of Penn balls and be entered in a drawing for great prizes including VIP passes, gift certificates and more.

Officiating

Players in Elite, A, B, C and D divisions must not have won the same or higher skill level at a national competition in the past 13 months. State association representatives will be consulted regarding the accuracy of entries. USA Racquetball reserves the right to re-classify and/or disqualify players if they are inappropriately entered.
