Once the league concludes, R2 Sports allows for easy rankings upload so USA Racquetball members can see their results in the National Rankings System. These results are also factored in should a new league member decide to become a full USA Racquetball member.

Jamboree league style that allows directors to maintain a racquetball challenge ladder in which players can compete and schedule matches against each other. Make sure Jamboree is in part of the event name for all the features to be activated.

Reduction of delayed or missed matches.

Jamborees can start and end at the Director's discretion, but 8 weeks' duration is recommended, from around 5:30 PM – 8:30 PM.

Jamboree games are typically played one day per week.

Players check in with the Controller present and are sent to a court with a same-level player to play one game to 15 points (11 if court availability or time is a factor).



Jamboree Leagues

At the conclusion of each Jamboree match, the Controller records the results and awards 3 points to the winner and 1 point to the loser. Points earned are totaled for the evening. A weekly cumulative total is emailed to each player. There are no makeup games. All games must be played during the designated time period.

On the 8th week of the session, the top 8 players in each category are placed in a bracket (quarterfinals, semifinals, and finals).

The goal of the Controller is to keep people playing. They may try not to repeat opponents, but there is no rule against this happening.

Fee Structure

The league participation fee is up to the Director.

USA Racquetball members do not pay a league membership fee.



Jamboree Leagues

If a player shows up for a single evening, the Director or Controller can simply collect the \$5.00 LEM League Fee, ascertain the competitive level, then assign the player to a court with an opponent. This method also works for out-of-town guests.

There is no specific mandatory arrival time, but if a player does not show up, there are no make-up matches. That player receives zero points. Even a lost match earns a player 1 point, so showing up will rank those players above those who did not attend.

Players can play as many games as they like and leave whenever they want.
