1. 2019/2020 Requirements grid will be posted by 9/1/2019:

The Figure Sport Committee has been working diligently on the requirements for this next season, partnering with the Regional Coaches Reps. We will have all Domestic events ready by 9/1/19, however, we are pending updates from World Skate on the International events and are not expected to have those updates, to publish until mid September. We will continue to work with World Skate to expedite the requirements and post them as soon as they are finalized.

2. First National Coaches Meeting:

On Wednesday, July 24, almost a hundred coaches attended a meeting led by Figure Sport Committee Chairman Ed Harney at the Spokane Convention Center. Ed presented updates on two main programs moving forward in the 2019/2020 skating season. He also showed how to access information on FSC updates on the Weekly USA Roller Sports Email blast and where to find the FSC Committee member Bio's, to show who are the hard working members for their Figure Sport are. Also below is the Powerpoint presentation that explained the new international dance and freeskating events for 2020 and that Domestic dance events will not change, per the request of the Coaches. Lastly, the Powerpoint showed the new judges commission structure that was met with applause on the direction to get new Judges into our competitive structure. The meeting was followed by presentations by Academy Leaders in freeskating and dance, presenting material from the Orlando World Skate seminar. The consensus of the Coaches was that we need to more discussions like these at Nationals and the FSC will look to have workshops at future Nationals.
