As one of the first coaches to be certified at the highest levels of coaching by both USA Triathlon and USA Cycling, Scott developed junior and age-group champions in both triathlon and cycling before he eventually led the national team programs for both USA Triathlon and USA Cycling. He is the only person to ever hold both roles. In between leading the U.S. National Teams for triathlon (2006-2010) and cycling (2017- March 2020), Scott was the High Performance Director at the United States Olympic Committee who coordinated sport science, facilities, logistics, technology and financial support for the athletes and coaches of USA Triathlon, USA Cycling, US Rowing, USA Sailing, USA Canoe & Kayak, the US Tennis Association, USA Badminton, USA Table Tennis, and USA Modern Pentathlon.

Scott has led teams at four Olympic Games, three Pan-American Games, over twenty World Championships and countless world cup and other international competitions. Scott earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Exercise Science from The Ohio State University, a certificate in Olympic Sport Leadership from the Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern University, Coaching Certifications from USA Cycling, USA Triathlon, and USA Track & Field, bike fit technician certification from Serotta, SafeSport Trained certification by the U.S. Center for SafeSport and CPR & First Aid certification from the American Red Cross. Through the years, Scott has built an extensive network of the top coaches, sport scientists, elite athletes, medical professionals, and sport administrators that he can call on when needed. Scott is also a frequent presenter and writer on high performance sport topics, coaching, and sports business.
